■ Conflicts of Interest Policy

It is the duty of every Region 5 Systems staff member and Network Provider to disclose any conflict of interest or any circumstances that might reasonably give rise to the perception of conflict of interest. Apparent or perceived conflicts of interest can be as damaging as actual conflicts of interest.

Region 5 Systems shall have procedures that address conflicts of interest that it may encounter with Network Providers, employees, and other community stakeholders. Such procedures shall include resolution of how conflicts of interests are handled when they arise.

Any provider within Region 5 Systems' Provider Network will be required to demonstrate that it has policies and procedures regarding conflicts of interest with its clients, employees, and stakeholders. Such procedures shall include resolution of how conflicts of interests are handled when they arise.
