■ Ineligible to Participate in Network Procedures

Standard 7.a.-c. Prospective Providers Determined to be Ineligible

Region 5 Systems seeks prospective providers only in the event that new funding becomes available or an existing Network Provider leaves the network. An open Request for Proposals (RFP) is announced once funding is available. Region 5 Systems informs prospective providers of the Minimum Standards to be accepted and enrolled into the Provider Network.

A prospective provider must submit documentation to demonstrate how it meets the Minimum Standards as a part of the open Request for Proposal process. The prospective provider must meet all of the Minimum Standards as well as all of the timelines and requirements as outlined in the Request for Proposals to be considered as eligible to join the Provider Network.

When an applicant is found to be ineligible due to not meeting Minimum Standards or RFP requirements, Region 5 Systems shall inform the applicant in writing as to the reasons for ineligibility, and provide information, in writing about resources to improve eligibility.

If an applicant is determined to be ineligible to be included in the Provider Network as a result of not meeting Minimum Standards and/or RFP requirements, there is no process to appeal the decision.
